KENDAL AMATEUR SWIMMING CLUB

RECORDS POLICY

Eligibility

Swimmer must be registered and training with a squad at Kendal Amateur Swimming Club on the date of the swim.

Swimmer must have swum the event at a Licensed Meet whilst representing Kendal Amateur Swimming Club, Cumbria County, ESSA North West Region or their country at an International Competition.

Club Records

Eligible members can set a Club Record whilst competing at level 1,2,3 or 4 meets recognised by British Swimming. Club records will be held for both Men and Women in both short and long course formats.

These records can be claimed by any age of swimmer (OPEN). Times set in any length of pool, shall not be converted using ASA equivalent performance tables, but shall be classified as Short Course and Long Course Club Records. Short Course Records may only be set in pools of 25m length and Long Course Records may only be set in pools of 50m length. The first swimmer in a relay event may apply for a Club Record if their time has been recorded and verified on the British Swimming rankings database.

The following distances and strokes shall be recognised for Kendal ASC Club Records.

Eligible members can set a Championship Record at Championship Events only.

All events (with the exception of the parent's race) in Kendal ASC Club Galas are Championship Events.

Claiming a record

An application for the recognition of any record must be submitted by completing the <u>record application</u> <u>form</u> which can be found on the website and submitted to the Records Officer. All records should be applied for within 28 days of the swim. A record can only be claimed for the named event in which the swimmer competes.

Verification of the record

The Records Officer will verify the record before awarding the record and presentation of a record certificate.
